Steve Carter

Raised on the family farm near Lowell, Steve was elected as Indiana's Attorney General for two terms defeating former Sec. of State and current Mayor of Indianapolis Joe Hogsett while receiving the highest number of votes for a state elected official in Indiana history (1,389,640). He put in place the nation's toughest Do Not Call law and successfully fought public corruption in East Chicago. Completing his term in 2009 he entered private business allowing him to spend more time with his wife and three teenagers at an important time in their lives. Randy Head

Randy Head's experience as a Deputy Prosecutor, an attorney in private practice, and as a State Senator uniquely qualify him to serve as Indiana's next Attorney General. He has tried over 100 jury trials and handled hundreds of felony cases – including 20 murder trials.
